The foundation spoke in front of the Jefferson Parish school board to help pass a vote to put AED's in Jefferson Parish high schools, middle schools, and in their stadiums. The school board passed the ordinance with a unanimous vote. As we write this letter they are getting ready to deploy 87 AED's. The foundation also spoke in front of the New Orleans City Council to create an ordinance to place AED's in their NORD playgrounds which passed unanimously. Since then they have passed the ordinance and are working on the placement of the AED's.

The Foundation has also made a donation to Parent Heart Watch to help in its efforts towards sudden cardiac arrest awareness in children.

In January, A. J. and Nancy attended a conference with Parent Heart Watch in Seattle, Washington. A large heart screening was done on 280+ children and ten percent were found with heart anomalies. One girl who was playing basketball at the college level was found to have a hole in her heart and two boys were found with possible HCM.

On 4/17/08, the foundation appeared on Channel 6 news with Dr. Corey Hebert, Medical Editor and Dr. Douglas Moodie from Ochsner Foundation Hospital. At that time, Dr. Hebert was doing a story on HCM in children which has helped to promote better testing in athletes and placing AED's at schools and sporting events. The foundation in its awareness efforts has talked in front of Kawanis Groups, St. Phillip Neri Mens Club, the Jefferson Playground Association, and at the Louisiana trainers conference held in New Orleans on June 7, 2008.
